Dear Parents and Carers



Next week is Children's Mental Health week and there will be a lot of activity in school supporting children to learn about how we keep ourselves healthy, happy and safe. In PSHE this term children have been using the NHS 5 steps to mental wellbeing to learn how to manage good mental health and I wanted to write to you about one of these steps that the children are keen to be involved in.

As a community we **give** so much to school through our Friends of Birdsedge group and children know and value how much this impacts on us as a school. However, when thinking about the **'give'** part of mental wellbeing, we decided that we wanted to give to something outside of

school as well, which is what I write to you about today.

As some of you may know, Miss Kimberley first joined us at Birdsedge First three years ago to complete her voluntary experience hours as part of her educational support adult qualification. Since finishing her studies, Miss Kimberley has continued to volunteer weekly in school and also has a role as part time lunch time supervisor and playworker. Miss Kimberley is the most positive person we know, she brings so much warmth and cheer to Birdsedge and we love to dance, play and learn from her! What a lot of you may not know about Miss Kimberley is that she is also a committed advocate for raising awareness and spreading inspiration for those affected by childhood cancer. Having survived cancer herself a number of times, Kimberley is currently organising a charity gala to raise money for those charities who have supported her over time in her journey. The children would



like to give back to Miss Kimberley by raising money to make the gala a success and contribute to the significant funds Miss Kimberley aims to raise. Led by school council, children have come up with a number of fundraising events they would like to be involved in from now until the Gala to help with this. These include:

- Tuesday 6th February Pound for Pancakes Day: Children can bring a suggested donation of £1 and have pancakes at school. There will be options to suit every child and special consideration has been given to those with dietary needs, allergies or intolerances so that this event can be accessed by all.
- Friday 23rd February Community Cafe: 2:30 4:00 pm, donations of baked goods very welcomed and everyone is welcome to call in at School for coffee, tea, and cakes to raise money for the Gala. Please bring cash to pay at the Cafe on the day, and share this date with friends and family!
- Friday 1st March Pyjama Party! from 5pm till 8:30, children can come to school for games and activities in the hall, including a mini-disco, karaoke and games, at a cost of £10 per child. A light snack will be provided along with hot chocolate or juice/water. We will then watch a film and children are welcome to snuggle up in their sleeping bags with their favourite teddy! Parents to collect at 8:30pm please.



- Friday 15th March Name the Birdsedge Mascot: Children will have the chance, for a suggested £1 donation, to submit their choice of name for the new Birdsedge First School mascot! The names will go into a draw and one winner will be chosen as the official name of our new mascot (from Build A Bear).
- Wednesday 10th April Sports and Fitness Day and Football Tournament: an idea from the children who have told us they would love a full day of sports, activity and competition! Through School Council discussions, children will choose the sports and events they would like to take part in throughout the day. There will be a football tournament during the afternoon which is already causing much excitement! Suggested donation of £2 per child to include some light refreshments.

Payment for all the events will be in cash please, due to the donations going towards the Gala. Payment can be made through the office or through your child's class teacher, in envelopes clearly labelled with the event and your child's name on them, so that we can make accurate records of participants.
